Result of Searches

Following receipt of your request searches were conducted within Greater Manchester Police (GMP) to locate the requested information. I can confirm the information requested is held by GMP.

Caveats:

In July 2019, GMP implemented one of the largest IT infrastructure changes in UK Policing. The systems are in continual development and the data provided for this request is what the systems currently hold.

1. The data provided for this request is based on a search of the HO crime codes for each of the areas with the exception of 'Domestic Abuse' which is based on a DV Flag being appended to the crime for the period 01/01/2018 to 31/12/2025.
2. The data is for female victims only - where the value is missing or unknown these have not been included within the figures.
3. Duplicates have been removed where possible.
4. Please note the date is based on the 'Crime Recorded' date and not when the Incident occurred.
5. The data provided for this request is subject to change as crimes are progressed and/ or updated.
6. 'Violence Against the Person' crimes comprises of both Violence with and without injury crimes.
